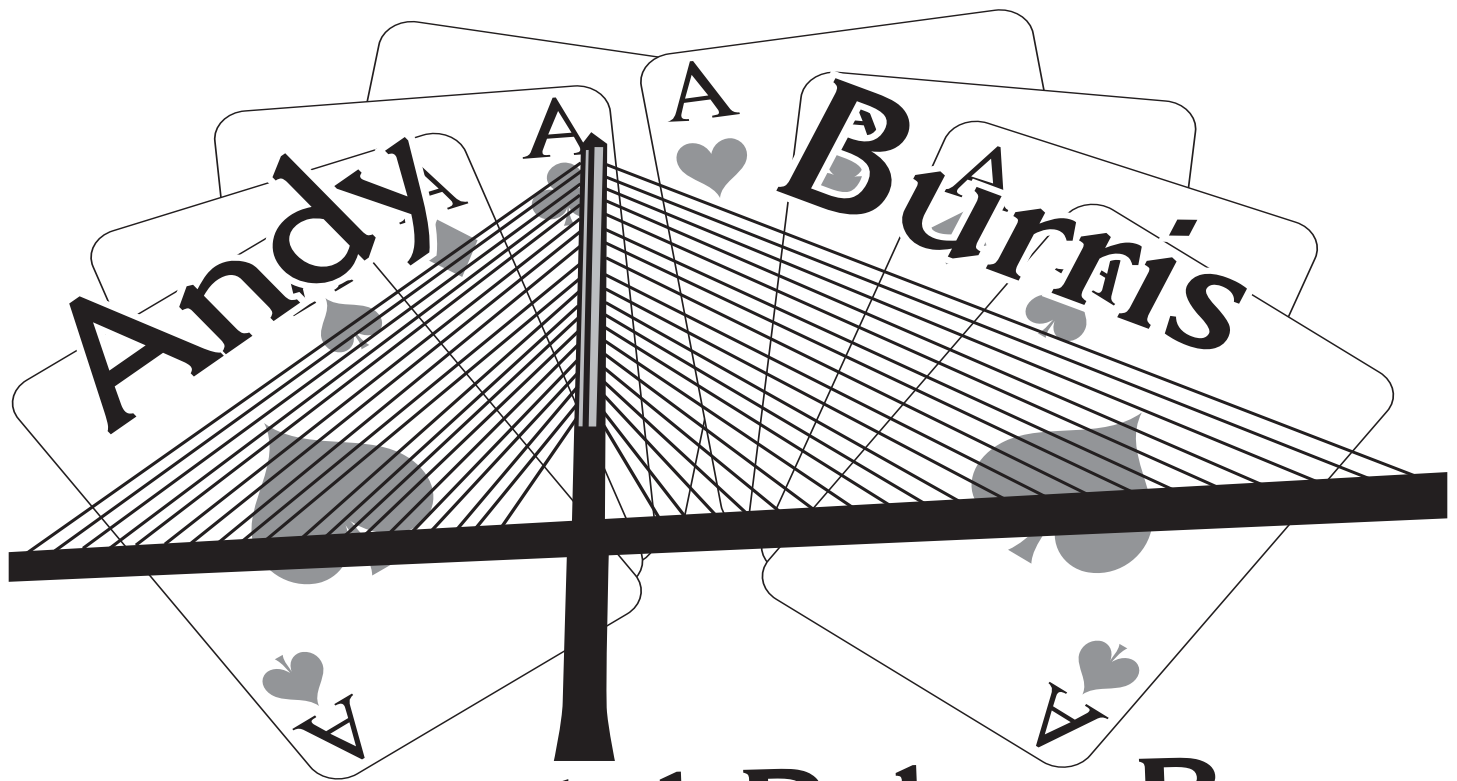


WILDABEAST PRESENTS the 2nd Annual

Who is Ty?

Ty is a happy, compassionate, brave and loving 4 year old who was born with Treacher Collins Syndrome, or TCS. He is a typically developing child, the only difference is that other 4 year old boys is the physical appearance. Ty wears hearing aids and has some facial deformity.

Ty has been through 13 surgeries to correct many of the facial malformations associated with TCS. He will undergo about 10 more surgeries by the time he is 20 years of age.

Ty was born without a nasal passage, cheek bone or ears. In addition he has an extremely small lower jaw. He has had surgery to create the nasal passage and jaw distraction to open his airway.

For specialized care Ty and his family travel to the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor to be monitored under the pediatric cranial facial team of surgeons. There is much more to tell about Ty Swoap so please visit www.tyswoap.com
